What is The Pocket?

The Pocket (formerly known as Smiths Yard) is between Hughenden Road, Elphinstone Road and Mount Pleasant Road. The entrance is through the arch between 4 & 6 Hughenden Road. It is usually open during daylight hours.

The Pocket has been transformed from an area of land that was derelict, covered in graffiti and notorious for flytipping. It now has raised beds that have been planted with shrubs and bulbs donated by Hastings Borough Council (HBC) and local garden centres. The Pocket has been actively supported by the British Trust for Conservation Volunteers, Tressell Training, Barclays Bank, HBC and local residents.

The Pocket has been used by **Better Braybrooke** as a community venue to hold events, and has also been used by other local groups, charities and churches.
